

Work undertaken in the Australian Age of Dinosaurs Fossil Preparation Laboratory includes the mechanical rediscovery of bones, restoration, repairs, consolidation of specimens, sieving, sorting of matrix for micro fossils and helping to put pieces of the dinosaur puzzle together.

- a guided tour of the Laboratory, Collection Room and Dinosaur Canyon
- a work health and safety induction and training with a Museum technician
- a copy of the latest Museum Journal (for new members)
