Before your visit

If possible, we recommend that you make a preliminary visit to the Museum or its <u>website</u> to familiarise yourself with the facilities and tour structures.

Browse our tours and activity add-ons and choose what will best suit your group. Before making your booking consider if any educational requirements or needs (including special access) are necessary. Please read the education excursion checklist (below) for more information about making a booking with the Museum.

Supervision

The Museum recommends a supervision ratio of 1:5 for prep students, 1:10 for primary school students (years 1-6), 1:15 for secondary school students (years 7-12) and a 1:1 ratio for students with special needs.

Teachers and supervising adults must implement effective supervision strategies when at the Museum. These strategies include ensuring students are wearing name badges and school uniforms, utilising Museum staff in case of emergencies, carrying out regular roll calls and discussing emergency meeting points.

Teachers must ensure students behave appropriately and follow instructions at all times (including those from Museum staff).

Payment information

All school excursions must be prepaid unless a commercial credit application has been submitted and approved.

The Museum provides <u>free admission for one teacher with every ten students</u> and one additional chaperone for every five students. Chaperones beyond the 1:5 ratio are welcome and need to purchase a student ticket upon arrival.

Note Transportation to the Museum and Dinosaur Stampede is not provided in the ticket price.

Q What are the latest tour additions at the Museum?

A In May 2021 the Museum opened the *March of the Titanosaurs* exhibition. This exhibition is only accessible via guided tour and features a 54m-long dinosaur tracksite that includes the best example of sauropod trackways in Australia. The tracksite was relocated from the bottom of a creek bed on a property near Winton and is enclosed in an architecturally designed and air-conditioned exhibition building, located 100 metres from Dinosaur Canyon Outpost. Life-sized bronze sauropods are positioned outside the building providing the perfect opportunity for selfies and school snaps. This guided tour is wheelchair accessible and runs for 30 minutes.

Q Are there any price or tour changes from 1 March 2022?

A Yes, there will be two changes. Firstly, education catering will increase (refer to page 5 of the education group rate sheet for more details). Secondly, the WDCOA VIP pass option for school group tours is being discontinued from 28 February 2022. Schools will still be able to see everything by booking an Ultimate Dinosaur tour and a Dinosaur Stampede tour.

Q When can I book the Gondwana Stars Observatory tour?

A Dark-sky tours through the Gondwana Stars Observatory are not available yet. When ready the Museum will update all schools about the new tour offering. The Observatory is situated approximately 50m from Dinosaur Canyon Outpost. A unique night tour will cater for up to 25 people per tour and run for one hour. As The Jump-Up is Australia's first International Dark-Sky Sanctuary, the addition of high-quality telescopes at the Observatory will enable visitors to see the extraordinary sky in Outback Queensland. The Observatory tour will be added to the rate card in due course.

Q What is the Museum's cancellation policy?

A Ordinarily the Museum's cancellation policy is: 30 days' notice – no charge applies, 14 days' notice – 50% of full tour cost per person and 7 days' notice – 100% of full tour cost per person. However, if cancellation is the result of COVID-19-related restrictions/closures the Museum will work with you to reschedule or refund any prepaid charges.

Q Can you host larger groups of students?

A Yes. Larger groups are welcome to visit the Museum. To ensure a better experience, larger groups are split into smaller groups each with their own Tour Guide.

Q When will the new virtual excursions be available for schools to book?

A The Museum's new virtual excursions will be available from October 2021 and include six curriculumlinked lessons: Fossil footprint forensics, Fossils in our backyard, Intro to Aussie dinosaurs, Digging into deep time, Dinosaur maths and Into the Laboratory: uncovering and understanding fossils. Prices will range from \$150 to \$200 per class.
